Dave Tetley - GE

- 1) They implemented a DCB enabled switch but couldn't use because of cabling – they use CX4 and the switch uses QSFP. Therefore they can't use the Mellanox switch.
- 2) Not just cabling issues – it is a protocol issues because each wire goes at a higher rate.
- 3) The 10 GbE switch is capable of supporting DCB and they are trying to get it enabled.
- 4) The customers are going to want 10 GbE to work.
- 5) A few more stages to go before they know what the RoCE issue is.

October 2012 Interoperability Test Plan Updates

- 1) See first draft of test plan for October 2012 Interop debug Event
- 2) iWARP Connectivity – deprecated
- 3) This has been deprecated because it was based on an old Java Test Suite. This has now been replicated by RDMA Interop and Stress using the OFA Training Code developed by Dr Russell from UNH-IOL.
- 4) Bob – The problem with iWARP Connectivity is that the PULP Interface shim has not been updated or maintained. So we are now focusing on Dr Russell’s solution
- 5) Intel MPI – we cannot make this mandatory because the OFA IWG charter stipulates that all tests must be open source.
- 6) Harry will discuss NFS over RDMA
 - a) Should work better with a higher kernel level
 - b) There is some problem with integration.

RoCE – not for October

- 1) Mellanox wants to focus on FDR and ConnectIB
- 2) Other players
 - a) Emulex
- 3) Bob Noseworthy
 - a) Good target for April
 - b) Need to get DCB involved
 - c) Need fabric other than Spanning Tree. Here are some options.
 - i) SPB - IEEE
 - ii) Trill
 - iii) MLAG – Extreme
 - iv) Fabric Path - Cisco
 - v) QFabric
 - d) OFA should add diagnostics and management for these fabrics.
- 4) Dave Tetley wants to know from Mellanox will they support long term. They are the sole real supplier
 - a) Guy – in the long term they want to support and test RoCE
 - b) Rupert – try to escalate.
